The Board of Pharmacy hereby amends Chapter 12, “Precursor Substances,” Iowa Administrative Code.

Legal Authority for Rule Making

This rule making is adopted under the authority provided in Iowa Code section 124B.2(2).

State or Federal Law Implemented

This rule making implements, in whole or in part, Iowa Code section 124B.2(2).

Purpose and Summary

The amendment temporarily amends Iowa Code section 124B.2(1) to add one chemical as a precursor substance in response to similar action taken by the federal Drug Enforcement Administration.

Public Comment and Changes to Rule Making

Notice of Intended Action for this rule making was published in the Iowa Administrative Bulletin on April 6, 2022, as **ARC 6280C**. No public comment was received. The amendment is identical to that which was noticed.

12.1(1) Amend Iowa Code section 124B.2(1) by adding the following new paragraphs:

ah. Methyl alpha-phenylacetoacetate (other names: MAPA; methyl 3-oxo-2-phenylbutanoate) and its optical isomers.
