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**COME NOW** the Iowa Board of Pharmacy ("Board") and Katie Ingalls ("Respondent"), 418 4<sup>th</sup> St SW, Cedar Rapids IA 52404, and enter into this Combined Statement of Charges, Settlement Agreement, and Final Order ("Order") pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10 and 272C.3(4), and 657 IAC 35.5. The Board has jurisdiction over Respondent and the subject matter of this case pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 17A, 155A, and 272C, and 657 IAC 36.

**A. STATEMENT OF CHARGES**

**COUNT I**

**WORKING WITHOUT CURRENT REGISTRATION**

1. Respondent is charged with failing to maintain a current technician registration with the Board while being employed as a technician in violation of 657 IAC 3.3, and may be disciplined pursuant to Iowa Code section 155A.6A(5) and 657 IAC 36.6(22).

**B. FACTUAL CIRCUMSTANCES**

2. Respondent's Iowa certified pharmacy technician registration number 28670 is currently active through July 31, 2021.

3. From February 2019 to October 2019, Respondent worked as a pharmacy technician without a current registration issued by the Board.

4. Respondent asserts that she mailed her application to the Board shortly after receiving national certification.

**C. SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND FINAL ORDER**

5. The Board has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of these proceedings.

6. Respondent acknowledges that the allegations in the Statement of Charges, if proven in a contested case hearing, would constitute grounds for the discipline agreed to in this Order.
