**COMES NOW**, the Complainant, Lloyd K. Jessen, and states:

1. He is the Executive Secretary/Director for the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners and files this Statement of Charges solely in his official capacity.
2. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 155A and 272C (1997).
3. On July 9, 1979, Douglas J. Fitzgerald, the Respondent, was issued license number 15485 by the Board to engage in the practice of pharmacy, subject to the laws of the State of Iowa and the rules of the Board.
4. License number 15485 is current and active until June 30, 1998.
5. Respondent's current address is 5304 S.E. Ninth, Des Moines, Iowa 50315.
6. Respondent is currently employed as the pharmacist in charge of Walgreens Advance Care Pharmacy #03417, 4446 N.W. 114th, Urbandale, Iowa 50322, and has been employed as such during all times relevant to this statement of charges.

**COUNT I**

The Respondent is charged with allowing an employee to practice pharmacy without an active and current Iowa pharmacist license in violation of 1997 Iowa Code §§ 155A.12(1) and 155A.12(6) and 657 Iowa Administrative Code Sections 9.1(4)(j), 9.1(4)(u), and 9.1(4)(v).

## THE CIRCUMSTANCES

1. On June 30, 1997, Johnna C. Folkmann's Iowa pharmacist license number 18144 expired and was not renewed. Since June 30, 1997, the license has been delinquent.

2. Johnna C. Folkmann was employed as a pharmacist by Respondent at Walgreens Advance Care Pharmacy #03417, 4446 N.W. 114th, Urbandale, Iowa from July 7, 1997, to August 28, 1997. Johnna C. Folkmann engaged in the practice of pharmacy at Walgreens Advance Care Pharmacy #03417 without a current and active Iowa pharmacist license.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that a hearing be held in this matter and that the Board take such action as it may deem to be appropriate under the law.

On this 3rd day of February, 1998, the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners and Douglas J. Fitzgerald of Des Moines, Iowa, each hereby agree with the other and stipulate as follows:

The licensee disciplinary hearing pending before the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners, on the allegations specified in the Statement of Charges filed against Respondent on October 14, 1997, shall be resolved without proceeding to hearing, as the parties have agreed to the following Stipulation and Consent Order:

1. That Respondent was issued a license to practice pharmacy in Iowa on the 9th day of July, 1979, as evidenced by Pharmacist License Number 15485, which is recorded in the permanent records of the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners.
2. That Iowa Pharmacist License Number 15485 issued to Respondent is active and current until June 30, 1998.
3. That the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter herein.
4. A Statement of Charges was filed against Respondent on October 14, 1997.

5. This Stipulation and Consent Order is entered into in order to resolve a disputed claim and constitutes no admission on the part of Respondent.


6. Respondent agrees to accept a citation and warning for the alleged violation set forth in the complaint. Respondent also agrees to submit a written report to the Board within thirty (30) days of acceptance of this Stipulation and Consent Order which outlines the action taken by Respondent to ensure that all pharmacists employed by Respondent in Iowa have an active and current Iowa pharmacist license.

7. Respondent shall fully and promptly comply with all Orders of the Board and the statutes and rules regulating the practice of pharmacy in Iowa. Any violation of the terms of this Order is grounds for further disciplinary action, upon notice and opportunity for hearing, for failure to comply with an Order of the Board, in accordance with Iowa Code section 272C.3(2)(a).

8. This Stipulation and Consent Order is subject to approval of a majority of the full Board. If the Board fails to approve this Stipulation and Consent Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party. If the Board approves this Stipulation and Consent Order, it shall be the full and final resolution of this matter.
