COMES NOW, the Complainant, Lloyd K. Jessen, and states:

1. He is the Executive Director for the Iowa Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter, "Board") and files this Statement of Charges solely in his official capacity.
2. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 155A and 272C (2011).
3. On July 25, 1995, the Board issued Jonathan P. Greko ("Respondent"), after examination a license to engage in the practice of pharmacy as evidenced by license number 18447, subject to the laws of the State of Iowa and the rules of the Board.
4. Respondent's pharmacist license is current and active until June 30, 2013.
5. Respondent's most recent address of record is 3327 Second Street Court, Moline, Illinois 61265.
6. At all times material to this statement of charges, Respondent was employed as a pharmacist at North Scott Pharmacy, 255 East LeClaire, Eldridge, Iowa 52748.

A. CHARGE

COUNT I – LACK OF PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY

Respondent is charged under Iowa Code § 155A.12(1) (2011) and 657 Iowa Administrative Code § 36.1(4)(b) with lack of professional competency as demonstrated by Respondent's (a) substantial deviation from the standards of learning and skill ordinarily possessed and applied by other Iowa pharmacists, (b) failure to exercise in a substantial respect that degree of care which is ordinarily exercised by an Iowa pharmacist and (c) willful and repeated departure from, and a failure to conform to, the minimal standard and acceptable and prevailing practice of pharmacy in the state of Iowa.

B. CIRCUMSTANCES


An investigation was commenced June 7, 2011, which revealed the following:

1. At all times material to this statement of charges, Respondent was employed as a pharmacist at North Scott Pharmacy, 255 East LeClaire, Eldridge, Iowa 52748.
2. During a "shopper survey" conducted by the Board, Respondent was presented with prescriptions for two drugs (Viagra and isosorbide dinitrate).
3. Although the Board's "shopper" was counseled, Respondent did not disclose a potentially dangerous drug interaction between Viagra and isosorbide dinitrate.
4. Respondent, who did not wear a name tag, only advised the "shopper" to not take the drugs at the "same time."

Wherefore, the Complainant prays that a hearing be held in this matter and that the Board take such action as it may deem to be appropriate under the law.

Pursuant to Iowa Code §§ 17A.10 and 272C.3(4) (2011), the Iowa Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter, "Board") and Jonathan P. Greko (hereinafter, "Respondent"), enter into the following Stipulated Citation and Warning settling a licensee disciplinary proceeding currently pending before the Board.

Allegations contained in a Statement of Charges against Respondent shall be resolved without proceeding to hearing, as the Board and Respondent stipulate as follows:

1. Respondent was issued a license to practice pharmacy in Iowa on July 25, 1995, after examination, as evidenced by Pharmacist License Number 18447 which is recorded in the permanent records of the Board.
2. The Iowa pharmacist license issued to and held by Respondent is active and current until June 30, 2012.

3. The Board has jurisdiction over the parties and jurisdiction over the subject matter of these proceedings.
4. Respondent was, at all times material to this Statement of Charges, employed as a pharmacist at North Scott Pharmacy, 255 East LeClaire, Eldridge, Iowa.
5. A Statement of Charges was filed against Respondent by the Board on

March 7, 2012. The Statement of Charges alleges that Respondent failed to counsel a patient regarding a potentially dangerous drug interaction.

6. Respondent has chosen not to contest the allegations set forth in the Statement of Charges and acknowledges that the allegations, if proven in a contested case proceeding, would constitute grounds for the discipline described herein.

7. Upon the Board's approval of this Stipulated Citation and Warning, Respondent shall be assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$500. This civil penalty shall be paid promptly after the Board's approval of this Stipulated Citation and Warning, by check made payable to the Treasurer of Iowa and mailed to the executive director of the Board. All civil penalty payments shall be deposited into the State of Iowa general fund.

8. Respondent agrees to obey all federal and state laws, rules, and regulations substantially related to the practice of pharmacy.

9. Should Respondent violate or fail to comply with any of the terms or conditions of this Stipulated Citation and Warning, the Board may initiate action to revoke or suspend Respondent's Iowa license or to impose other licensee discipline as authorized by Iowa Code chapters 272C and 155A (2011), and 657 Iowa Administrative Code § 36.1.


10. This Stipulated Citation and Warning is the resolution of a contested case. By entering into this Stipulated Citation and Warning, Respondent waives all rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations contained in the Statement of Charges, and waives any objections to this Stipulated Citation and Warning.

11. The State's legal counsel may present this Stipulated Citation and Warning to the Board.

12. This Stipulated Citation and Warning is subject to approval by a majority of the full Board. If the Board fails to approve this settlement, it shall be of no force or effect to either the Board or Respondent. If the Board approves this Stipulated Citation and Warning, it shall be the full and final resolution of this matter.

13. The Board's approval of this Stipulated Citation and Warning shall constitute a FINAL ORDER of the Board.

This Stipulated Citation and Warning is voluntarily submitted by Respondent to the Board for its consideration on the 18 day of May 2012.


