COMES NOW, the Complainant, Lloyd K. Jessen, and states:

1. He is the Executive Secretary/Director for the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners and files this Statement of Charges solely in his official capacity.
2. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 155A and 272C (2005).
3. On February 20, 1980, the Board issued Respondent, Jeffrey D. Longstaff, following examination, a license to engage in the practice of pharmacy as evidenced by license number 15652, subject to the laws of the State of Iowa and the rules of the Board.
4. Respondent's pharmacist license is current and active until June 30, 2007.
5. Respondent's address is 1678 Summit Lake Avenue, Creston, Iowa 50801.
6. Respondent is employed as the pharmacist-in-charge at the Medicap Pharmacy, 405 Sumner Avenue, Creston, Iowa 50801.

A. CHARGES

COUNT I – DEPARTURE FROM PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS

Respondent is charged under Iowa Code § 155A.12(1) (2005) and 657 Iowa Administrative Code § 6.14 and 36.1(4) with a lack of professional competency, including repeated departure from, or failure to conform to, the minimal standard or acceptable and prevailing practice of pharmacy in the State of Iowa.

COUNT II – ENGAGING IN UNETHICAL CONDUCT

Respondent is charged with engaging in unethical conduct in violation of Iowa Code § 155A.12(2) (2005) and 657 Iowa Administrative Code §§ 8.11(1) and 36.1(4)(c) by providing generic medications to a customer without notice to the customer.


COUNT III- FAILURE TO ACT AS PHARMACIST IN CHARGE

Respondent is charged with failing to perform the duties of a pharmacist in charge in violation of Iowa Code §§ 155A.12(1) (2005) and 657 Iowa Administrative Code § 6.2.


B. CIRCUMSTANCES

Pursuant to Iowa Code §§ 17A.10, 272C.3(4) (2005) and 657 I.A.C. 36.1(2)(j), the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners (hereinafter, "the Board") and JEFFREY D. LONGSTAFF (hereinafter, "Respondent"), enter into the following stipulated Citation and Warning, settling a licensee disciplinary proceeding currently pending before the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners.

Allegations specified in a Statement of Charges filed against Respondent shall be resolved without proceeding to hearing, as the Board and Respondent stipulate as follows:

1. Respondent was issued a license to practice pharmacy in Iowa on February 20, 1980, after examination, as evidenced by Pharmacist License Number 15652, which is recorded in the permanent records of the Board.
2. The Iowa Pharmacist License issued to and held by Respondent is active and current until June 30, 2007.
3. A Statement of Charges was filed against Respondent on January 26, 2006.
4. Respondent was, at all times material to the Statement of Charges, employed as the pharmacist-in-charge at Medicap Pharmacy, 405 Sumner Avenue, Creston, Iowa 50801.
5. The Board has jurisdiction over the parties and jurisdiction over the subject matter

of these proceedings.

6. For the purposes of this stipulated Citation and Warning, Respondent does not contest the allegations set forth in the Statement of Charges. Respondent accepts, pursuant to 657 I.A.C. § 36.1(2)(j), this Citation and Warning.

7. As a part of this Citation and Warning, Respondent agrees that, within sixty (60) days after the date of the Board's approval of this Citation and Warning, he will propose to the Board – for immediate implementation at MEDICAP PHARMACY – *typewritten* (or computer generated) pharmacy policies and procedures regarding (a) drug product selection/generic substitution; (b) utilization of pharmacy technicians; (c) dispensing and delivery of prescriptions; (d) controlled substance recordkeeping; (e) outdated medications; (f) verification of prescriptions using NDC numbers; (g) development of unique identifiers for each pharmacy employee, and (h) development of logs containing information regarding which pharmacists and technicians are at work at specific times.

8. Should Respondent violate or fail to comply with the terms or conditions of this Citation and Warning, the Board may initiate action to revoke or suspend Respondent's Iowa license to operate a pharmacy or to impose other licensee discipline as authorized by Iowa Code chapters 272C and 155A and 657 Iowa Administrative Code § 36.1.

9. This stipulated Citation and Warning is the resolution of a contested case. By entering into this stipulated Citation and Warning, Respondent waives all rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations contained in the Statement of Charges, and waives any objections to this stipulated Citation and Warning.


10. This proposed settlement is subject to approval by a majority of the full Board. If

the Board fails to approve this settlement, it shall be of no force or effect to either the Board or Respondent. If the Board approves this stipulated Citation and Warning, it shall be the full and final resolution of this matter.

11. Upon the approval of this Citation and Warning, the Circumstances set forth in Attachment A to the Statement of Charges filed January 26, 2006, are a matter of public record.

12. The Board's approval of this stipulated Citation and Warning shall constitute a **FINAL ORDER** of the Board in a disciplinary action.

This stipulated Citation and Warning is voluntarily submitted by Respondent to the Board for its consideration on the 25 day of August 2006.
