COMES NOW, the Complainant, Lloyd K. Jessen, and states:

1. He is the Executive Secretary/Director for the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners and files this Statement of Charges solely in his official capacity.

2. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 155A and 272C (1997).

3. On December 26, 1997, the Respondent was issued pharmacy technician registration number 1749 by the Board, subject to the laws of the State of Iowa and the rules of the Board.

4. Registration number 1749 is current until December 31, 2000.

5. Respondent's current address is Rural Route 1, Box 114, Cambridge, Iowa 50046.

6. Respondent is currently employed as a pharmacy technician at Mortar & Pestle Veterinary Pharmacy, 3701 Beaver Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50310.

COUNT I

The Respondent is charged under Iowa Code §§ 155A.6(7) and 155A.23 (1997) and 657 Iowa Administrative Code § 22.18(1) with a prohibited act.

THE CIRCUMSTANCES

Investigative findings indicate that Respondent removed pharmaceutical products from the Mortar & Pestle Veterinary Pharmacy in order to conceal them from regulatory officials during an inspection on February 10, 1998.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that a hearing be held in this matter and that the Board take such action as it may deem to be appropriate under the law.

COME NOW the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners (“the Board”) and Denise L. Snyder, (“Respondent”) and, pursuant to Iowa Code §§ 17A.10 and 272C.3(4) (1997), enter into the following Stipulation and Consent Order settling the contested case currently on file:

The registrant disciplinary hearing pending before the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners, on the allegations specified in the Statement of Charges filed against Respondent on May 12, 1998, shall be resolved without proceeding to hearing, as the parties have agreed to the following Stipulation and Consent Order:


1. That Respondent was issued a pharmacy technician registration in Iowa on the 26th day of December, 1997, as evidenced by Technician Registration Number 1749, which is recorded in the permanent records of the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners.
2. That Iowa Technician Registration Number 1749, issued to and held by Respondent is active and current.
3. Respondent is not currently employed as a pharmacy technician.
4. A Statement of Charges was filed against Respondent on May 12, 1998.

5. That the Iowa Board of Pharmacy Examiners has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter herein.
6. Respondent agrees to accept a citation and warning for the alleged violation set forth in the Statement of Charges.
7. Respondent shall fully and promptly comply with all Orders of the Board and the statutes and rules regulating employment as a pharmacist technician in Iowa. Any violation of the terms of this Order is grounds for further disciplinary action, upon notice and opportunity for hearing, for failure to comply with an Order of the Board, in accordance with Iowa Code § 272C.3(2)(a).
8. The Respondent shall obey all federal and state laws, rules, and regulations substantially related to employment as a pharmacist technician.
9. Should Respondent violate or fail to comply with any of the terms of this Consent Order, the Board may initiate action to revoke or suspend Respondent's Iowa pharmacy technician registration or to impose other licensee discipline as authorized in Iowa Code chapters 272C and 155A and 657 Iowa Administrative Code § 22.18.
10. This Stipulation and Consent Order is the resolution of a contested case. By entering into this Stipulation and Consent Order, Respondent waives all rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations contained in the Statement of Charges, and waives any objections to this Stipulation and Consent Order.
11. This proposed settlement is subject to approval by a majority of the full Board. If the Board fails to approve this settlement, it shall be of no force or effect to either

party. If the Board approves this Stipulation and Consent Order, it shall be the full and final resolution of this matter.

12. The Board's approval of this Stipulation and Consent Order shall constitute a **FINAL ORDER** of the Board in a disciplinary action.

13. This Stipulation and Consent Order is voluntarily submitted by Respondent to the Board for its consideration on the 20 day of January, 1999.




