COMES NOW the Iowa Board of Pharmacy ("Board") and Mark Tedrow ("Respondent"), 2202 14th Ave., Sterling, IL 61081, and enter into this Combined Statement of Charges, Settlement Agreement, and Final Order ("Agreement") pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10(2) and 272C.3(4) (2013).

1. Respondent holds Iowa pharmacist license number 14628, which is currently active and expires on June 30, 2016.
2. The Board has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of these proceedings.

A. STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Count I

PRACTICING PHARMACY WITHOUT AN ACTIVE LICENSE

3. Respondent is charged with practicing pharmacy without an active and current Iowa pharmacist license in violation of 657 Iowa Administrative Code rule 2.11(2), pursuant to Iowa Code section 155A.12(1) and 657 Iowa Administrative Code rule 36.1(4)(v).

B. FACTUAL CIRCUMSTANCES

4. Respondent's pharmacist license number 14628 expired on June 30, 2013.
5. On February 25, 2014, Respondent was informed by his employer that his license had expired.
6. On February 26, 2014, Respondent self-reported to the Board that he had been working in Iowa without a proper license since July 1, 2013.
7. Respondent has since reactivated his pharmacist license.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND FINAL ORDER

8. Execution of this Combined Statement of Charges, Settlement Agreement, and Final Order constitutes the resolution of a contested case. Respondent has a right to hearing before the Board on the charges, but Respondent waives the right to hearing and all attendant rights,

including the right to appeal or seek judicial review of the Board's actions, by freely and voluntarily entering into this Agreement. This Agreement shall constitute the final order of the Board in this case and shall have the force and effect of a disciplinary order entered following a contested case hearing.

9. Respondent admits that the allegations, if proven in a contested case hearing, would constitute grounds for the discipline agreed to in this Combined Statement of Charges, Settlement Agreement, and Final Order.

10. Respondent is freely and voluntarily entering into this Agreement. Respondent agrees that the State's counsel may present this Agreement to the Board and may have *ex parte* communications with the Board while presenting it.

11. Upon the Board's approval of this Settlement Agreement and Final Order, Respondent is hereby **CITED** for practicing pharmacy without an active license and **WARNED** that Respondent's failure to comply with the laws governing the practice of pharmacy in the future could result in further discipline.

12. Respondent agrees to pay a civil penalty in the amount of five-hundred dollars (\$500). This civil penalty shall be made payable to the Treasurer of Iowa and mailed to the executive director of the Board within thirty (30) days of the Board's approval of this Settlement Agreement and Final Order. All civil penalty payments shall be deposited into the State of Iowa general fund

13. Should Respondent violate the terms of this Agreement, the Board may initiate action to impose other licensee discipline as authorized by Iowa Code chapters 272C and 155A (2013) and 657 Iowa Administrative Code chapter 36.


14. This Agreement is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board does not approve this Agreement, it shall be of no force or effect on either party, and shall not be admissible for any purpose in further proceedings in this matter. If the Board approves this Agreement, it shall be the full and final resolution of this matter.

15. This Agreement, when fully executed, is a public record and is available for inspection and copying in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code chapters 22 and 272C.


16. This Agreement shall not be binding as to any new complaints received by the Board.

17. The Board's approval of this Agreement shall constitute a **FINAL ORDER** of the Board.
